

### ABOUT THE NORTH AUSTRALIAN FESTIVAL OF ARTS

The North Australian Festival of Arts or "NAFA" is a hybrid festival with both Fringe and curated events.

Launched in 2019 off the back of Townsville's Commonwealth Games project, Festival 2018. After a massive success in its first year, Townsville City Council decided to make the festival a part of Townsville's annual event calendar. Celebrating culture and diversity, NAFA shines a light on Townsville's creative talent and continues to grow in numbers with over 250,000 attendees, 4000 showcasing artists and 400 event staff, providing a significant annual economic boon injecting more than \$25 million into the Townsville economy since 2019 and taking home the 2022 Best Regional Event at the Australian Event Awards.


In 2024 NAFA will transform Townsville for 18 magical days and nights from Thursday 26th September to Sunday 13th October.


# **2023 NAFA SNAPSHOT**

If you are a brand-new artist and want to feel out the industry, Fringe gives you opportunities to mingle with seasoned Fringe artists from all over the industry, and essentially learn from the best of the best.

#### **COSTS INVOLVED**

Registration is FREE in 2024

#### WHAT DOES THE FESTIVAL PROVIDE?

- If your show is programmed within the NAFA festival hub, standard venue and production will be provided.
- Venue and operational staff support, this does not include show-specific staff eq. Stage managers or stage crew.
- Ticketing setup via the NAFA ticketing website and the facilitation of ticket sales.
- Event listing on the NAFA website
- Standard event listing in the NAFA program
- Access to support from the NAFA team

#### **TICKETING**

All shows are required to use the NAFA ticketing system in 2024

If you are bound with any contractual ticketing requirements - please contact our team to discuss.

#### **FEES AND CHARGES**

70% of gross ticket sales go to the artist and 30% to the festival.

# WHAT YOU WILL NEED PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE

Events held on council-controlled land or in a council-controlled venue require event organisers (or artist groups) to hold a minimum of \$20 million in Public Liability Insurance. Public Liability Insurance (PLI) covers any incidents or claims made by members of the public.

You will be asked to provide your certificate when registering.

#### **MARKETING MATERIAL**

Once you have registered our team will reach out to request images and a description of your show. If you don't have these or they are not up to date, it's time to get snapping!
