Over the past two years, six local First Nations groups - the Wulgurukaba Walkabouts, Big Eye Theatre Dancers, Komet Dancers, Obery Sambo, Meriam Dancers, and Bindal Dancers - have come together for the first time in decades to connect, collaborate and co-create a new performance work alongside Dancenorth Australia.
